

Installation Instructions for the New Pixera Driver

Camera System: 120es, Professional, Personal, PVC-100, PVC-100C

Software Applications: 120es Application Suite and VCS (Visual Communication Suite)

Operating Systems: MacOS 8.5–9.2

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Revision: 1.0

Please follow the steps below,

Installation of Pixera Driver

Step 1.

Uncompress the driver files, with Stuffit Expander or WinZIP.

Step 2.

Desktop Users (PCI card):

Drag & drop the Pixchip PCI driver file into the Extensions folder inside the System Folder on your hard drive. If prompted to replace the current driver, click OK.

Notebook Users (PCMCIA card):

Drag & drop the PixeraPCCardEnabler file into the Extensions folder inside the System Folder on your hard drive. If prompted to replace the current driver, click OK.

Step 3.

The second file is Pixera VDIG. It creates video communication between the Pixera camera and third party video conferencing software, i.e. Net meeting, etc. If you don't have this capability installed, drag & drop this file into the Extensions folder inside the System Folder on your hard drive.
